
Astwick Newsletter February 2024



In the month of January the Bluebells have enjoyed celebrating a few different things. We spoke a lot about New Years Eve and had some lovely activities based around fireworks. The children shared some of the things they did over Christmas and New Year which included some amazing celebrations!

As it has been super cold this month the children have loved exploring ice and the effects the weather has on it. They explored some of the large puddles that had frozen over on the field and looked at the frozen water in the garden too. We extended their interest of ice into inside, setting up trays with frozen flowers inside ice that they had to crack to retrieve, along with making our own icicles and exploring "ice" colours - of course this included conversations around Elsa!

The children have really enjoyed learning about birds for the Big Bird Watch. They made their own bird feeders that they carefully placed at our new forest school area and took their binoculars that they made to see what birds they could find, checking them off in our bird book!The one we spotted the most was a little Robin Redbreast that likes to visit the garden in the mornings



For national Story week we have been busy reading stories and using puppets was really funny too. We will be continuing this throughout February.


Next month we will be busy celebrating Chinese new year. We will be busy with Valentine arts and crafts and Pancake day is also around the corner.

Valentines day - 14th February


The annual celebration of love and a day to tell others around you how much they mean to you. The children will be creating some cards and pictures to share with those they love.
